2025 Border Competitions - Jim Clark Memorial Rally

Thank you to all volunteer Marshals and Radio Operators who have offered assistance for this year's event. With less than two months until the cars start from Market Square in Duns, there are still opportunities to join for one, two, or all three days.

We welcome Borders Competitions as title sponsors of the 2025 Jim Clark Rally. Borders Competitions is an online skill-based raffle site offering prizes like TVs, phones, cars, and luxury holidays.

The Borders Competitions Jim Clark Rally will run from 23-25 May 2025 around Duns in the Scottish Borders.

It is a round of the Prodrive British Rally Championship, Asset Alliance Group Scottish Rally Championship and Protyre National Asphalt Championship.

Friday morning will see crews complete a shakedown at a location close to Duns before starting from the Market Square in early evening for the first of two runs through Langton, Fogo and Bothwell in the evening.

Saturday will see crews return to Langton before heading to Edrom, Blackadder and Polwarth and back to Duns for service. After a second run of the stage's cars will return to the Market Square for the ceremonial Finish.

Onto Sunday when competitors in the Reivers Rally will tackle a revised stage in Westruther, a new stage in Mack's Mill and then onto Scott's View and Eccles, again all run twice before returning to Duns to spray the Champagne.

Service will again be on the outskirts of the town where there will be much more space.

Whether you are an in-stage marshal, prefer undertaking timing duties or are a Motorsport UK licenced Radio Operator there are roles for you all. All signed on volunteers will receive a Supermarket voucher, goody bag and we have again negotiated a discount of food from Blackadder Mini Market and Deli on the rally route in Greenlaw.

We look forward to seeing you out on the stages at the end of May.
